Naming policy for the LT top-level domain

Draft version 0.2

5 Jul 1994

1. Introduction

This memo provides information on the Structure of the names in the Domain Name System (DNS) for Lithuania. The basic rules for registration and for the LIT DNS registration authority (only referred to as "registration authority" below?—sire also documented. A significant portion of this document builds on the information in RIA and most of the other parts document the so far undocumented but practiced rules for DNS registration in the LIT domain.

- Rules for choosing names
- 2.1 Generally speaking, the DNS name space under .LT is for the time being structured organizationally. This has the following implications:
 - An organization should only register a single domain name for itself.
 - A sub-organization should not register directly under the .LT domain; the parent organization should instead register and the sub-organization should be allocated an appropriate name under the parent organization's domain.

The .LT registration authority keeps open the formal definition of what constitutes an organization.

- 2.2 The applicant is probably best served with a domain name which is easily associated with the organization of the applicant. This can be done by registering a well-known abbreviation for the organization or the complete organization name. The applicant should observe that there is a tradition for keeping the registered names short, but in order to reduce the chance for future name collisions, registered names should contain at least 4 characters.
- 2.3 The use of "generic categories" (such as, AC, CO, GO, RE etc.) under the .LT domain is going to be phased out, and no new registrations will be done in these categories.
- 2.4 Initially there shall be no geographical names registered directly under .LT. Parititioning of the name space according to (political) geography is deferred for further study.

We recognize that not doing this partitioning may lead to long-term scaling problems, but we choose to disregard this issue for the

Till 1997 very strict registration rules, free registration

- Only for legal persons
- Min 3 characters, few exceptions for 2 characters
- City names only for municipalities
- Country names only for embassies

1994 – 1995 TCP/IP was installed & .lt domain transferred to Lithuania




- April, 1997 fee for registration introduced
- 1997 2000 change of registration criteria, no more strict rules
- June, 2004 IDN
- 13, March, 2007 New procedural regulation, reduction of registration fees
- March, 2008 IPv6 introduced
- 6, April, 2009 100 000 domains
- 31, January, 2013 .LT secured with DNSSEC



- 15, September, 2014 introduction of multiyear registration
- 21, December, 2015 .LT strengthened the protection against DDoS cyberattacks
- 3, June, 2017 .LT turns 25!
- 3, November, 2017 accountability framework was signed with ICANN
- June, 2019 ISO 27001




Registered .lt domains






IDN domains











.LT domain distribution by starting symbol











.LT domain distribution by Registrant country
